"Pencoed Town Council is concerned that the Austerity programme has brought about the failure of smaller County Borough Councils to deliver services in an equitable ,efficient and effective way.

Education and Public Transport are two typical services that are rapidly becoming postcode lotteries with cuts in the Education budget causing some schools to operate on deficit budgets and the lack of funding for the Bus routes impacting greatly on those residents such as the elderly and disabled who may be unable to drive but may live in outlying communities.

The twenty two existing Authorities are competing within the labour market for the most skilled employees in services such as Social Services and Education adding to the "postcode lottery syndrome"

Inflation busting rises in the Community Charge for diminishing and poorer services are the order of the day and must be addressed.

Pencoed Town Council calls upon the Welsh Government to introduce Local Government Reform as soon as practicable, to reduce the inequality that is being enhanced by the current system of Local Government and in doing so create larger Councils thus bringing about economies of scale to minimise the most severe and significant effects of the Austerity Programme."
